Re-Imagine BLOCK Fest® Virtual Build with BLOCK Fest® Event



Event Overview:: COVID-19

The following overview is a Virtual Build with BLOCK Fest® event, intended to provide an additional option for a BLOCK Fest® in-person event until COVID-19 restrictions allow for a Re-Imagine BLOCK Fest® In-Person event or an originally designed BLOCK Fest® event.

Host:

- Minimum of one trained BLOCK Fest® Host to facilitate a Virtual Build event
- Event Reporting must be completed through Host Portal at <u>www.blockfest.org</u> for each event
- Host is responsible for advertising event and providing any necessary volunteers for event assistance
- Host facilitates the block play...have a plan
 - Essential to Include:
 - Use "I Wonder" statements
 - Ask questions
 - Point out concepts they are building or using, share definitions, etc
 - Math words, science words, story words
 - Let the child lead with their structure, asking questions, not telling them what to do or not to do as they build
 - Options to Incorporate:
 - Plan specific block types separately, rotating after a set amount of time to another type
 - Build with all block types together
 - Demonstrate concepts and have them explore it
 - Have someone build a structure, then have others replicate it
 - Host builds, then families
 - Parent builds, then child
 - Show the BLOCK Fest® 8 Stages of Block Play Video
 - Unit cube pattern card exploration and demonstration

Timeline:

Events can be configured into a one-hour event or shortened.

- The length of time your event lasts should be determined by the outline of activities you have created.
- Consider the ages of children participating; target time length towards the youngest age group and their ability to remain engaged.

Event Supplies:

- Block set for each participating family
 - We recommend using a Mini-Block Bag for each participant; this gives consistency in block options for all your participants (inquire with Twiga)
- Internet access for Host and each Participant
- Zoom app downloaded and account set-up (other online platforms can be used)

Event Registration:

Registration for your event is recommended using the new BLOCK Fest® Registration Application

Online Platform:

- Twiga will set up a registration link specific to your event
- Registration Application allows Host to track participant registration, waiver signing, survey completion and print a registration log for easy check-in

Blocks:

Mini-Block Bag:

- Twiga can assist you in determining the best method to obtain blocks for your event
 - Purchase Mini-Block Bag Event Packages through Twiga
 - Identify blocks for your organization to purchase
- Host will make arrangements to get blocks to participants prior to event
- Block bags (sets) can be gifted or loaned to participants
 - If loaning block bags, it is the responsibility of the Host to properly sanitize all materials, coordinate delivery and pick-up of all materials

Participants:

 Recommended 8 families for participation (this is the easiest configuration for an iPad; 9 participants visible on the screen at one time)
